Scientific Observations :

- There is a **Significant INCREASED ISOLATION**

In Seniors: +77% “social deaths”, 2017 to 2021



- In Youth (15-24yrs), depression:

From 4% in 2014 to 22% in 2020 (INSERM-DREES)

- ISOLATION leads to frailty, chronic disease,
and a costly loss of autonomy



- **SOCIAL INVOLVEMENT**
is the primary Proven Factor for Longevity
(CNRS, PM Lledo, 2022: genes are protected)
- The **Intergenerational Virtual Village**
is an innovative solution

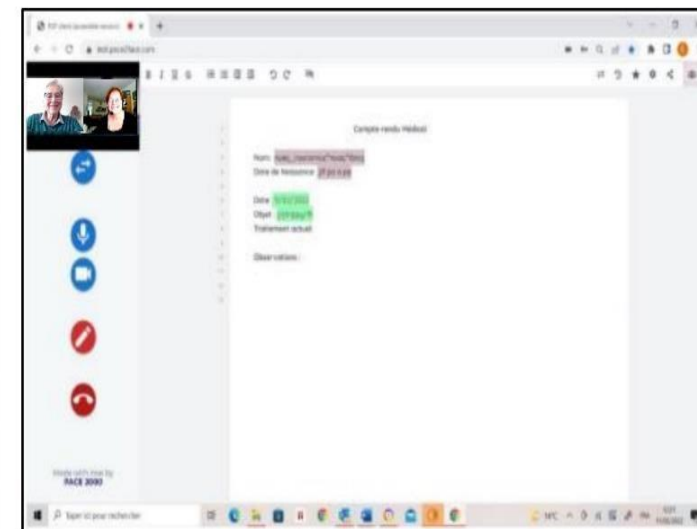
